

Dress Code

In the interest of clarity and simplicity, LCA's dress code has two options. The options are as follows:

- 1) Students may wear their LCA school apparel which includes.... all LCA logo t-shirts, sweatshirts, etc. LCA school apparel only consists of t-shirts and sweatshirts, therefore students may wear bottoms from the French Toast Uniforms (FTU) list or jeans (see guidelines below for approved jeans). Contact the school office for ordering LCA apparel.
- 2) Parents may choose from the approved French Toast Uniforms list (FTU). <u>Contact the school office for the links to the approved FTU apparel.</u>

Parents may select any items from the approved list. **Parents are not expected to order from each link**. Some of the links may say toddler, but once it's opened it allows ordering from all sizes. Also, these items can be found on the following websites......Amazon, Kohl's, Walmart. If your child(ren) already have some of these items from their previous school, they may wear those items **as long as they are in good condition**.

If you have a child with significant (medical) sensory issues, please contact the school office and a link for items better suited for their needs will be sent to you.

Dress Code Guidelines

All clothing should be modest, clean, neat and in good repair. No holes or fraying...this includes coats and jackets.

All students:

- Jeans....nice and solid denim colors of dark blue, light blue or black.
- Socks are to be worn. **Dark** solid colors or white. No neon- bright-colored socks are permitted.
- Hats or hoods may not be worn in the classroom or inside the building. Outside is permitted.
- Plain/solid-colored belts of a coordinating color are permitted.
- Hair has to be clean, neatly trimmed and brushed/combed. <u>Hair fads, colors and styles are not permitted.</u>
- Body piercings are not permitted.
- All clothing must fit properly. Excessively loose or tight/form-fitting clothing is not

acceptable.

Shoes:

- Shoes are to be worn at all times.
- Closed in tennis shoes, or the like with no more than two colors....Closed in shoes are required for safety reasons! For this reason, shoes without holes in them are to be worn.
- Footwear such as sandals, flip flops, crocs, or any other variation of open toe/open heel footwear is not permitted.
- Dress shoes.....solid dark colors.
- Snow boots...solid colors without patterns.
- <u>Cowboy boots are discouraged</u>. It's difficult to play in them, therefore they can present safety issues.
- No neon- bright-colored shoes or laces are permitted.
- Shoes that light up or have roller wheels are not permitted.
- Shoes may not have a heel higher than 1". This is for safety reasons.

Girls:

- Leggings/tights must be <u>solid colors</u> that correspond with the uniform.....(black/dark blue/white/tan-beige.)
- Solid-colored leggings/tights or shorts are to be worn under skirts and dresses that correspond with the uniform...(black/dark blue/white/tan-beige.)
- Leggings/tights can only be worn under dresses, skirts, skorts, pants or shorts.
- Minimal jewelry is allowed. One pair of earrings is permitted along with one other piece of jewelry in the form of a bracelet or necklace (as long as they do not become a distraction).
- Makeup is not permitted in grades 1-6.

Dress Code Non-observance:

The following procedures will be administered to students when the dress code is not followed.

5th level and down:

- 1st incident: parent contact
- 2nd incident: parent contact and parent will be asked to bring a change of clothes
- 3rd incident: student is sent home

6th level and up:

- 1st incident: verbal warning to student from teacher and/or administrator
- 2nd incident: parent contact and parent will be asked to bring a change of clothes
- 3rd incident: student is sent home
